

## **Key Points from Risk Assessment**

Hazard	What School will do	What Parents and Carers will do
All children in school, every day.	<ul> <li>Provide Staggered start/end/break/lunch times to ensure bubbles don't mix.</li> <li>Maintain good time keeping to ensure staggered sessions work smoothly.</li> <li>Promote and reinforce social distancing with children, staff and parents.</li> <li>Arrange classrooms in a way that is safe and conducive to learning.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Drop and pick up child/children at designated times.</li> <li>Send child/children to school every day (unless unwell) to re-establish routine.</li> <li>Only one adult will collect and drop off child/children.</li> <li>Not congregate on the playground.</li> <li>Maintain social distance from other families.</li> </ul>
Visitors and contractors on site.	<ul> <li>Arrange any contract work to be completed before or after school where possible.</li> <li>Contractors to wear a mask at all times on site.</li> <li>External agencies will wear a mask where social distancing cannot be maintained.</li> <li>Use the Track and Trace system to ensure contact is available should the need arise.</li> <li>Employ a clean routine - sanitise and wash hands on entry.</li> <li>Minimise contamination of bubbles and provide safe working conditions for outside agencies (clean work stations and socially distanced spaces).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Minimise time on site and limit to one adult per family collecting where possible.</li> <li>Where a facemask unless medically exempt as will staff at the beginning and end of the day on the playground.</li> <li>If an appointment is required with a member of staff arrange this over the phone/email to ensure safe conditions can be arranged.</li> <li>Use Class Dojo as main form of communication.</li> <li>Send in letters, dinner monies in a sealed envelope with child's name and class and put in the box in the front office – we can then make arrangements to safely open and quarantine any paperwork as necessary.</li> <li>Adhere to safe social distancing.</li> </ul>
Ensure well-being of staff and children is paramount and all parties informed of illness and procedure.	<ul> <li>Ensure children are reassured and informed of why and how we are taking the precautions through additional PSHE lessons appropriate to age.</li> <li>Inform parents/carers of Covid related illnesses and implement process as necessary.</li> <li>We will complete temperature checks of staff and children if they present as unwell and inform relevant family member.</li> <li>Provide vulnerable members of staff and children with additional support where necessary through intervention and counsellor.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Reinforce good hand hygiene and social distancing outside of school.</li> <li>Talk to your child/children about any concerns or worries they may have.</li> <li>Keep children off school if unwell.</li> <li>Inform school of any illness of child or members of the household Covid related or not on the day of absence.</li> <li>Self-isolate as recommended should Covid symptoms be present and seek to get a test as soon as possible.</li> </ul>



## **Key Points from Risk Assessment**

Further lockdowns and isolation impacts on education.	<ul> <li>School will provide children who are isolating, or if we go into another lockdown, work appropriate to need or child.</li> <li>School to enhance learning experience by using new learning platforms (Google Classroom and Class Dojo).</li> <li>School will provide guides and support for parents/carers to support their children.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Support and encourage your child/children to engage with at home learning.</li> <li>Parents/carers to sign up to the Class Dojo system.</li> <li>Parents/carers to ensure contact details are correct so that ParentMail can be delivered and you can remain informed.</li> </ul>
Ensure cleaning is fit for purpose to ensure the prevention of Covid.	<ul> <li>Rigorous cleaning routine strictly adhered to.</li> <li>Additional cleaning hours in place.</li> <li>Thorough deep clean over summer and weekly to ensure the prevention of Covid.</li> <li>Clean routines adhered to by all staff in school.</li> </ul>	Ensure clean routines are practiced at home and good hygiene is promoted.
Loss of learning during lockdown.	<ul> <li>Gaps analysis completed by teachers to ensure all children catch up.</li> <li>Evaluation of the curriculum to ensure best learning opportunities to make all learning.</li> <li>Provide support and differentiated learning to meet the needs of all pupils.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Complete homework tasks with your child/children.</li> <li>Engage with new online learning platforms and ask if you need help.</li> </ul>
Wrap around care	<ul> <li>Provide service from 21<sup>st</sup> September after risk assessment has proved it is fir for purpose.</li> <li>Arrange children in bubble groups and move to a larger space (hall) to facilitate this.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Only use the facility if you really need it.</li> <li>Book in for the sessions at least 48 hours in advance.</li> </ul>
